Waxing and winding yarn into balls

It is extremely important to paraffin and wind correctly the yarn.

The best way of preparing yarn is to wind it in two stages:

At the first stage take the end of yarn from the center of the ball and fix it at the winder. Take a piece of paraffin in the left hand, let slip yarn on the piece of paraffin while pressing slightly and turn the crank of the winder by the right hand.

The yarn thus waxed is too much tight and cannot be used in the knitting machine. It must be wound again.

At the second stage, pose the yarn ball by ground, take the end of yarn from the center of the ball and fix it at the winder.

Make pass wool between the fingers of the left hand without tightening it and turn the crank of the winder by the right hand. Attention not to hold the yarn too tightly in order to obtain a soft ball.

While knitting, start with the end of yarn from the center of the ball. If the yarn does not flow freely and smoothly, the ball has been wound too tightly, and must be wound again to avoid difficulties. A ball reeled too tight can cause serious troubles in knitting.
